



FloydFest 9: Breaking Ground Festival Volunteer Guidelines (Revised 6/2/10)

Help us create FloydFest 9 by joining our fabulous volunteer workforce! Volunteers work scheduled job shifts in exchange for a weekend (4-day) pass. As a FloydFest volunteer, you will help create the most sensational music festival on the east coast!

*Volunteers have perks: early access to prime campsites and the joy of being part of our festival family. Plus – volunteers are invited to an exclusive festival kick-off celebration, featuring music, food and drinks (***Please see Volunteer FAQ for changes to our parking guidelines**).*

PLEASE NOTE: Only volunteers who receive confirmation of an approved application will be accepted. Preference will be given to returning FloydFest volunteers.

Volunteer Guidelines

(See separate guidelines and application for pre-festival volunteering)

- **Only volunteers who can commit to all four days of the festival will be considered.** Each volunteer is required to complete four 4-hour shifts for a total of 16 volunteer hours over the four days.
- Volunteer arrival times are:
 - o 9am - 6pm on Wednesday, July 21nd or
 - o 9am – 1pm on Thursday, July 22rd
- **Volunteers must arrive by 1pm on Thursday, July 22!** Please allow time to set up your campsite. Bring a photo ID for verification when you check in.
- A \$10 non-refundable processing fee must accompany every application. This must be a separate check from the \$140 deposit.
- A \$140 deposit is required from ALL volunteers. Deposits must be in the form of a check made out to Across-the-Way Productions. After you complete your volunteer commitment, your check will be destroyed. **If you fail to fulfill your volunteer commitment, we will deposit your check.**
- You may cancel your volunteer commitment and receive a full refund of your deposit if you notify us by Friday, July 16th.
- Volunteers must be at least 18 years old, or 13-17 years old and working with a parent or guardian.
- Application Deadline is Friday, July 2; notification of acceptance will sent by July 9. (**Note:** Schedule preferences are "1st come, 1st served," so the sooner we receive your application, the better.)
